

NOTICE CONCERNING THE PROTECTION OF PERSONAL DATA

Dear Candidate Members,

We know you care about how we use your personal data and we appreciate the trust and confidence you have in us for handling that information carefully and reasonably. This Notice is intended to inform you about the particular personal data collected and processed by the Bulgarian Society for the Protection of Birds, UIC 121244539 (herein referred to as "BSPB", "we" or "us") with regard to the establishment of the membership relationship between you (in your capacity as candidate members and subsequently as members of the Society) and BSPB, as well as your resulting rights by virtue of Regulation (EU) 2016/679 (General Data Protection Regulation or "GDPR" for short) and the provisions of the applicable national legislation.

Pursuant to Art. 13 of the GDPR, we would like to inform you of the following:

Who is the data controller?

The personal data controller is BSPB, which means that we determine how and why your personal data is collected and processed. The address for correspondence with the personal data controller is the management address of BSPB. You can also contact us as indicated in the "Further questions" section below.

What kind of personal data do we process?

We collect and process personal data from all our members and candidate members, namely first name, middle name, surname, personal ID number, contact details such as address, phone and e-mail, profession, workplace, occupation. We only collect the minimum possible volume of information in view of the purposes for which the personal data is used, as indicated below.

We process the specified categories of personal data for the purpose of concluding and executing the membership agreement and fulfilling the relevant obligations in connection with the membership relationship established between you and BSPB, in compliance with the Bulgarian legislation. Thus, we process your personal data on the basis of Article 6(1)(b) (for the performance of a contract to which the data subject is a party or for taking steps at the request of the data subject prior to entering into a contract) and Article 6(1)(c) (for compliance with a legal obligation that applies to the data controller) of the GDPR. When necessary, we may request your explicit consent to process other specific categories of personal data. You can withdraw your consent with regard to these additional categories of personal data at any time by following the instructions provided when you gave your consent or described in the contact details in the "Further questions" section below.

How and why do we process your personal data?

The personal data we collect from you upon registration or later helps us manage the membership relationship with you, for example payment of membership fees, participation in BSPB's general meetings, provision of information about our activities, but also compliance with our legal obligations and implementation of BSPB's activities, with a view to effectively establish and prevent conflicts of interest. If a member fails to provide BSPB with the personal data needed, BSPB will not be able to properly fulfil the Society's legal obligations to inform them of the implemented activities and to enable them to participate in the management of the organization, as a result of which we will be forced to refuse to establish or, respectively - to terminate the membership relationship with that particular person.

How do we store and process your personal data?

BSPB stores the personal data of each member on paper and electronically - a scanned membership application form, and maintains an e-database containing the members' personal data, which we use to communicate with you, keep accounting records, etc. Access to your personal data is only provided to those BSPB employees, who need it to achieve the objectives described above, or whose professional duties imply such legal requirements. These persons include the operations managers of BSPB and the employees in the "Communication and Membership" department.

For how long do we store your personal data?

BSPB stores personal data in accordance with the requirements of the law and as long as this is necessary to achieve the above objectives, or as long as it is required by the relevant legislation. Certain data categories, for which no express storage periods have been officially stipulated, may be stored until the expiration of the limitation periods for bringing civil claims by or against BSPB envisaged in the national laws and regulations.

According to the provisions of Art. 35, para. 2 of the Statutes of BSPB, the data about persons of terminated membership are stored in the Archive of the Society for at least 10 years following the date of the event.

Does BSPB disclose personal data to third parties?

BSPB will not disclose your personal data to third parties - state authorities, companies and non-profit organizations, natural persons, etc. except in cases where:
- the latter has received your express consent;
- the information is requested by public bodies or officials who, according to the legislation in force, are authorized to request and collect such information, adhering to the legally established procedures;
- other cases specified in the relevant laws. Under certain circumstances, we are obliged to share your personal data with third parties, doing this in full compliance with the established personal data protection regulations and laws. These persons will act independently as controllers of your personal data and will be responsible for complying with the relevant legal requirements for the protection of personal data. Such third parties are, for example, administrative bodies (NRA or NSSI) or law enforcement bodies (police, prosecutor's office, etc.).

How is your personal data protected?

We undertake appropriate technical and organizational measures to ensure the protection and security of your personal data. In particular, we have implemented and apply appropriate physical, electronic, and procedural security measures against illegal or improper processing of personal data as well as against accidental loss or damage of personal data.

What rights do you have under the data protection legislation?

You have the right to request access to, correction, deletion or restriction of the processing of your personal data, to request data transferability, as well as to give instructions regarding the processing of your personal data following your death. You also have the right to object to the processing of your personal data in certain cases. If we process your personal data based on your consent, you can withdraw it at any time.
